

Reserve a boat through ASA directly or through any participating ASA School.

This is the information on reserving a boat directly through ASA. We will be using new 40 foot boats from The Moorings. These yachts are equipped with three staterooms and are ideal for groups up to 7 individuals. Each boat will be stocked with an "Easy on the Cook" provisioning package. This will provide food for all breakfasts, most lunches and a few dinners. Dinner for everyone at the Captain's Table at The Bitter End Yacht Club is also included. A transom BBQ is also provided for cooking onboard.

Bareboat certification is available to Basic Coastal Cruising graduates who attend this week program. The cost is \$285.00 extra for text book, certification fee and instruction. Bareboat charter graduates can subsequently skipper their own boat cruising in the Caribbean and other locations around the world.

Fill Your Own Boat Option

If you have your own group and are qualified to skipper, you may charter your own boat to join the Flotilla instead of joining individually or as a couple.

We will have many events planned throughout the week, including a treasure hunt with wonderful prizes and gifts, rum parties, picture events, and many opportunities to meet sailors from around the world.

Total cost includes the boat for 7 nights, lodging at the Mariner Inn in Tortola December 1 and December 9 (double occupancy), Easy on the Cook provisioning, airport transfers in Tortola, National Park Fee, Bitter End Yacht Club dinner and ASA Registration and parties. Airfare is NOT included.
